Thank you for the comment and the article on hepatitis B detected by PCR in smoke plume samples. However, to the best of my knowledge-ignorance, the presence of pieces of DNA does not demonstrate the presence of a living virus. I would not be surprised that after the virus is cooked and exploded (=vaporisation) fragments of virus DNA remain sufficiently intact to be detected by PCR.

My interest in living viruses in the smoke plume is not limited to this Corona virus bus is triggered by the observations on the microbiome of the peritoneal cavity, of the presence of HPV and other infectious agents in endometriosis.
